Head's Corner

I am now approaching the end of my second year as Headteacher of Harrow Way. I have no idea where the time has gone, but it has been a wonderful experience. I would like to thank the staff, students, governors and parents for all their support throughout the year. This time last year we had just had our Ofsted inspection. As you will be aware we were graded 'good' in all areas under this new challenging framework. With this in mind we have started planning for our next 3-year strategic plan. We have involved all stakeholders in our school community in this process of building our "Vision for Harrow Way Community School in 2018". Vision can mean different things to different people, collectively; I hope we'll shape something ambitious and exciting but also grounded and practical for HWCS to work on over the next 3 years.

We had a very successful visit from our Leadership and Learning Partner (LLP) Jean Thorpe. This involved a discussion with me about self-evaluation and student data, a learning walk across the school, visiting a number of classrooms, a discussion with middle leaders and SLT and student interviews with a selection of Year 10 students.

The Harrow Way Community School parents' survey took place in May 2014 to gauge parental satisfaction with the school and to gain feedback on subjects that are pertinent to school development. The online survey was emailed to all parents on the school database, via a web link. A total of 164 responses were received. A summary of the findings are included as a separate insert with this Newsletter.

Summer Term

The summer term, like many others, is always

busy, active and enjoyable. We have had a wide range of activities taking place, including a successful outdoor activities trip to Calshot for 60 Year 8 students. Students have also returned from visits to Krakow and Ghana and there has been the normal fixture lists for rounders, tennis and athletics to cram in before the end of term. Year 9 and Year 10 students have entered the world of work via Enterprise Davs, learning what it takes to design, produce and market new products. Year 10 students have also had a taster day at Andover College. in preparation for the next step in their education. The French Department ran very successful Bastille Day Celebrations on the 14th July, extending our knowledge of French history and culture. Our Unicef Peer Educators also met with Police, Local Authority personnel and Southampton Solent academics and have devised an Internet safety workshop. Our sporting highlight this term has to be on Friday 23rd May when on a bright and sunny evening in Southampton, the Harrow Way School Year 8 football team were crowned Hampshire Champions after a thrilling 1-0 win over Hounsdown School in what was an exact rematch of last year's final.

We have also held our Year 7 and 8 and Year 9 and 10 Presentation Evening, which gave us an opportunity to celebrate the achievements of students. Other events held this term have been the Year 9 Dance/Drama Showcase and the Year 10 BTEC Showcase.

Sports Day

On Wednesday 3rd July we held our annual Sports Day. This year's sports day took on a new format, with every student in school taking part in an activity. The day started with an opening ceremony, which consisted of a dance from the afterschool dance club. Morning activities began and students were playing for their house teams in rounders, softball, tennis and tug-of-war.

After break, the field events started which included javelin, discus, long jump and track running. After lunch the students all gathered

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to watch the hurdle and relay races. The day ended with a staff tug-of-war.

The overall winners of the day with 1480 house points were Buzzards.

Year 11

Year 11 Leavers were almost unrecognisable when they arrived for their Prom this term. It was a wonderful night to remember for all of them and a fitting end to a very successful and hardworking year group. We look forward to seeing them again in August to celebrate their exam results.

Uniform

I continue to be very proud of our school uniform and the vast majority of our students adhere to our expectations at all times. with school leaders; it is a partnership of focused, determined and dedicated professional practitioners. This year we have used a number of strategies to support students who have examinations in 2014.

GCSE results will be available from the school on Thursday 21st August between 10am and 12 midday. If you do not intend to come to school that day to pick up your result slips, a stamped, addressed (A5) envelope should be left with Mrs Cook in the uniform office. All remaining result slips will be held at the school for collection at the beginning of the September term.

These result slips are often requested by admissions officers for Further Education courses.

CHANGE OF TELEPHONE NUMBERS AND ADDRESSES

It is most important that any change of mobile or landline number, or home address is reported to the school. Please ensure you notify the School Office as soon as possible of any changes to your contact details, particularly daytime telephone numbers, so that we are able to get in touch if the need arises.

Savings for your family

You could make savings of around £380 per year if your child qualifies for free school meals. This will also result in a Uniform Grant Allowance for children in Years 7, 9 and 10 (currently worth approximately £60 per year) and also depending on distance from home to School, possible travel assistance.

To make sure your child doesn't miss out, there is now a quick and easy online checking service for you to check your eligibility for an instant result, all you need to do is enter your name, national insurance number or asylum number, your address and your child's details. Press 'submit' and you will find out if you are eligible.

If your result comes back 'found' this means your child is eligible for free school meals and the system automatically tells us.
