## IT Technician

The duties and responsibilities for this role include:

- Work with the schools IT team to deliver excellent first line technical support to staff and students across the school, resolving basic issues and working with the rest of the team and external providers as necessary.
- Act as first line support to the Primary Schools that the school provides an IT Support SLA, taking telephone calls, e-mails and support tickets. Work remotely where possible, or directly on site with our supported schools where necessary, to resolve issues and perform maintenance as required.
- Assist with day-to-day network management tasks including user and password management, access requirements, software and hardware requirements.
- Assist with lifecycle management of IT hardware, including specifications, purchasing and provisioning of new equipment, asset management, ongoing support and ultimately decommission and disposal.
