Dear Parent

As we enter the last half term of the academic year, I am writing to parents regarding special arrangements for this term and for the beginning of next.

This Term

Year 7 Parent Consultation Day/ Year 6 Induction Day

This will take place on Tuesday 3rd July. The school is closed to Years 7-10, unless students are helping with the Induction Day or have an appointment with a Year 7 Tutor. Work will be set for all other students to complete at home. Year 7 reports will be sent home on Friday 29th June.

Year 10 Parents Evening

This will take place on Monday 9th July between 4 pm and 7 pm. I expect all parents to attend appointments with their child's subject teachers. A letter containing further details will be sent out shortly. Year 10 reports will be sent home on Friday 6th July.

Olympic Flame

In common with other local secondary schools, the Governors have decided to close the school at 1.30 pm on Wednesday 11th July. This is in order to allow students and staff the opportunity to view the Olympic Flame with their families and also to ensure students living in outlying villages are able to get home on that day before road closures as well as having the opportunity to view the flame as it passes by their locality.

Year 9 and 10 Enterprise Days

These will take place during the last two weeks of term and a compulsory part of the work-related learning curriculum. All students are therefore expected to attend on these days.

Sports Morning

Weather permitting, we are holding a Sports Morning on Thursday 19th July. All students should attend school on that day wearing their PE kit, whether or not they are participating in the competition.
