- Began as a Saxon village and first appears in history around 950 AD
- The Domesday Book said that there was a total population of around 500 people in 1086
- By 14th century there were around 1400 people
- Made money from wool and leather





- In 1569 a school for boys was set up in Andover (John Hanson)
- The plague struck Andover in 1603, 1625 and 1636
- By 18th century around 30 stagecoaches passed through Andover every day
- 1785 Ladies Walk was built



 1875 Water pipes were built to directly pump water into Andover

- By 1960 it was decided that Andover should become an 'overspill' town for London
- The plan was that, by 1982, the population should rise to 42000
- Floral Way, Cricketers Way, River Way, Admirals Way, King Arthurs and Roman Way were all built in 1960s
- In 1960s many industrial estates were built including the Twinings factory



- More recently we have had more building at Augusta Park
- People from Europe have come to Andovernotably from Portugal (at first to work at Vitacress) and then from Eastern Europe, Nepal and other countries
