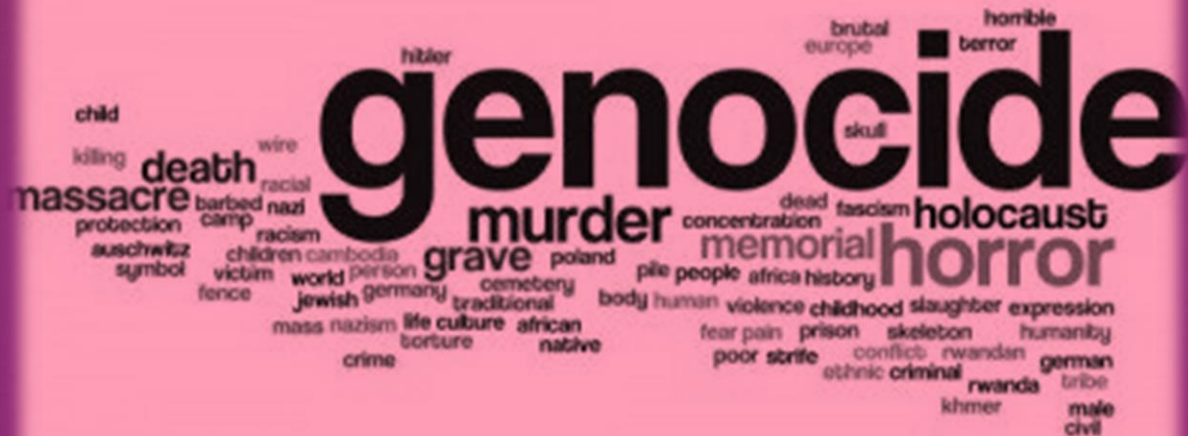

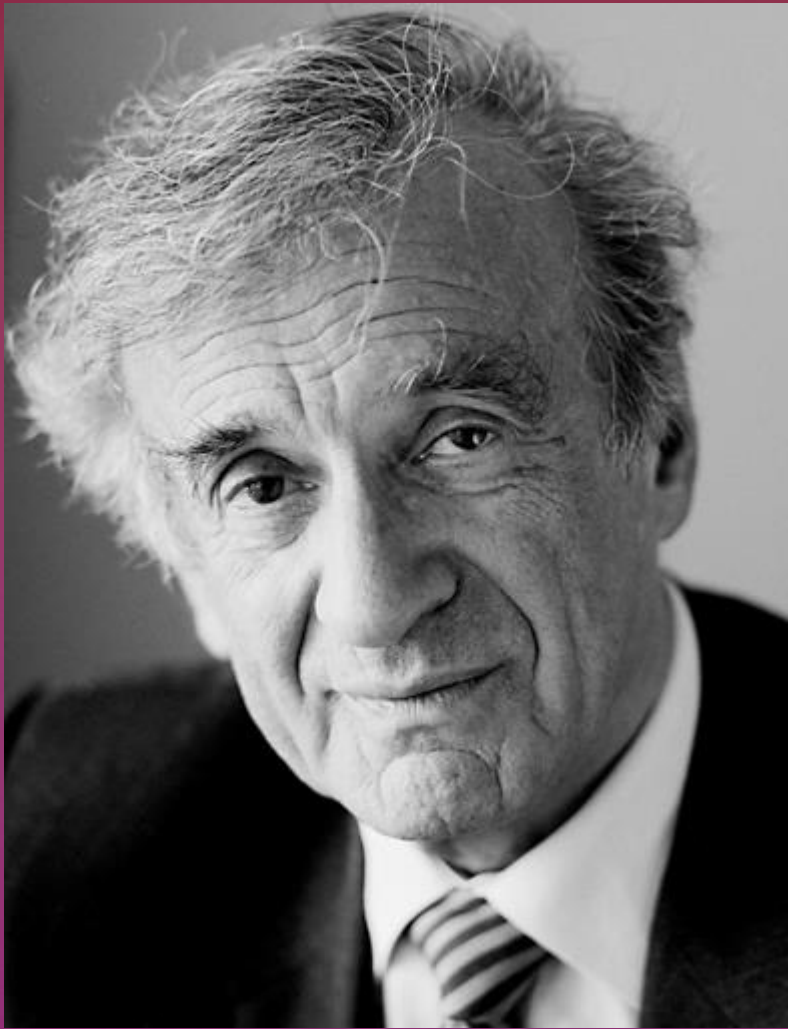
Genocide in Darfur

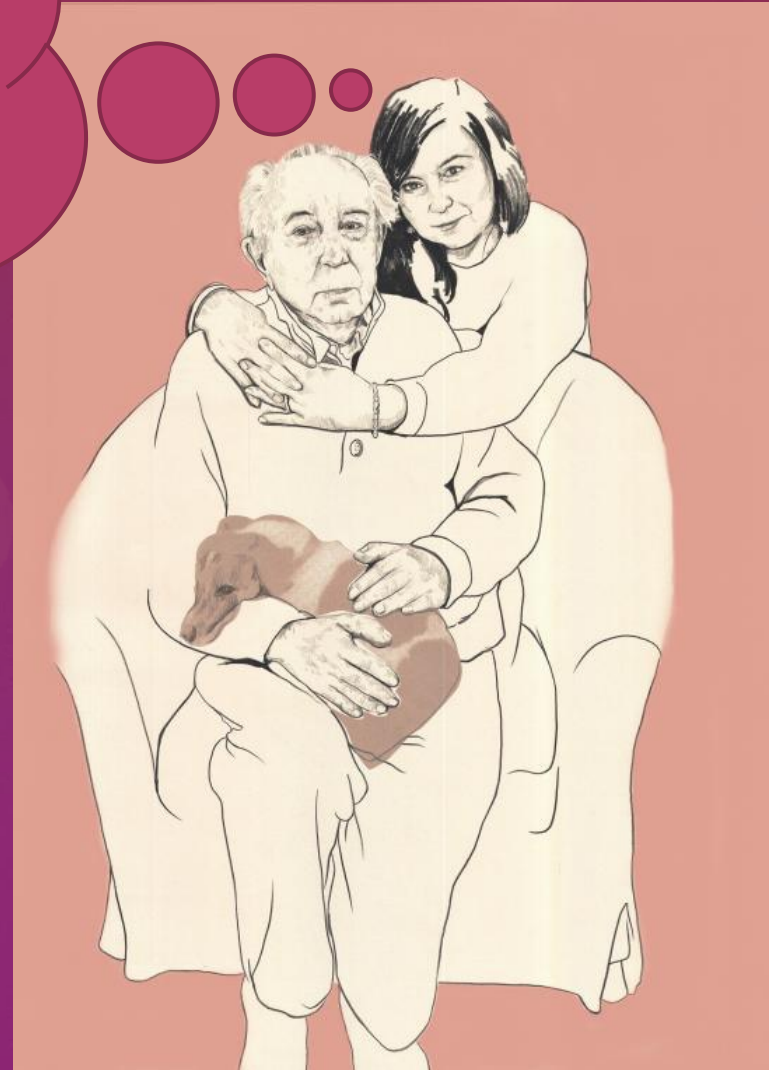
