Every year we undertake an evaluation of our performance, acknowledging our successes and also identifying the areas that we need to improve. Parental input is essential if the process is going to be truly meaningful and the evidence we collect helps to determine the priorities for the year ahead and the longer term. The information we receive from the questionnaires is summarised below and overleaf. The information has been discussed at Senior Team Meetings and a Full Board Governors' Meeting. We have identified four areas we would like to include in the School Improvement Plan 2018-2019.
