
# Attendance is **crucial** in Year 11

Why?




## **Progress 8 Score by Attendance Level**

#### Grades

You will be awarded grades 1 to 9 in your GCSE and BTECs.

A grade 4 is a pass at GCSE and a grade 5 is a good pass.
