Spring Term 2021



We are passionate about and committed to offering a varied and engaging [programme of activities](#) for students at Harrow Way. This builds on a successful legacy of sports clubs and performing arts opportunities and includes a commitment to providing engaging and challenging STEM activities. KS4 students are also offered the opportunity to achieve a Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award working with Andover Baptist Church. All year 7 and year 8 students are encouraged to take part in at least one weekly enrichment activity (our initial target is for at least 75% of year 7 and year 8 students to attend). We are actively encouraging and challenging girls to take part in more STEM related opportunities. We invite and encourage outside agencies and businesses to support and engage with activities. We [celebrate success](#) and attendance at enrichment; Heads of Year are encouraged to identify barriers to taking part with support being offered and provided to tackle issues if possible with a particular focus on SEND and disadvantaged students. Student voice activities are used to collect feedback on enrichment activities and to inform decisions about future opportunities with many clubs and societies now being formed and run by our senior prefect team.
