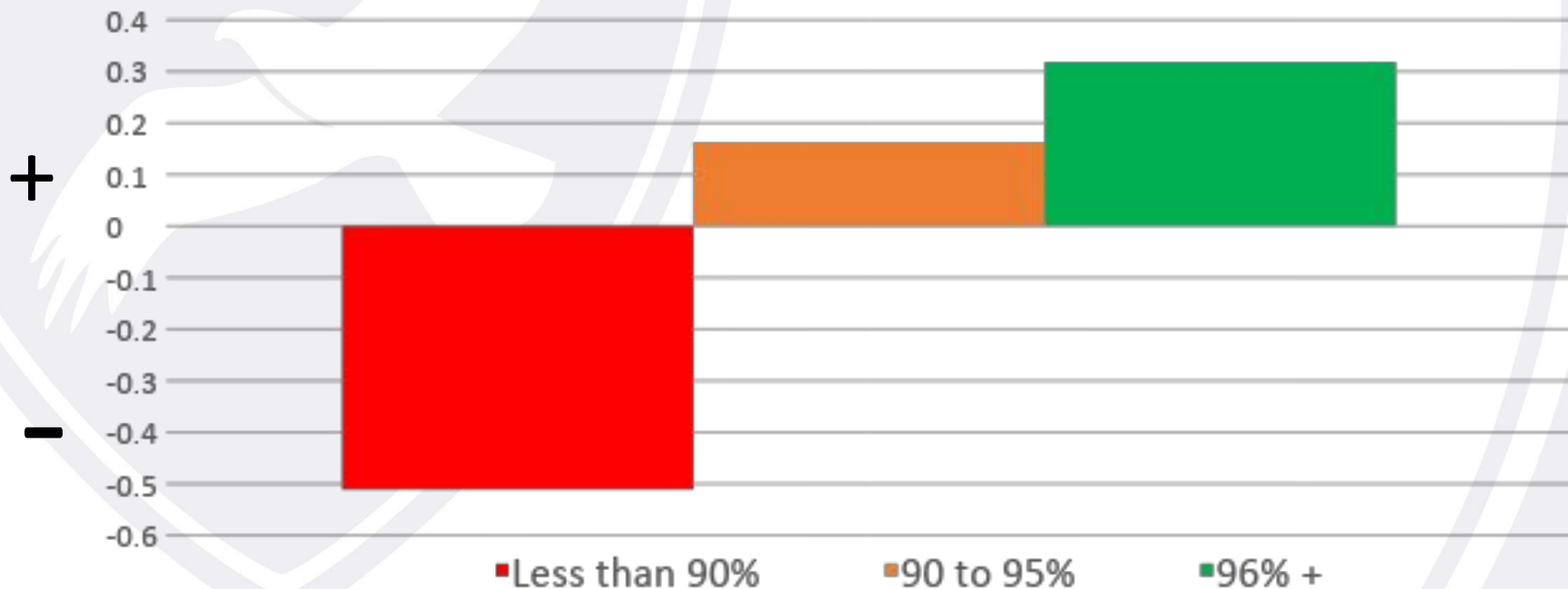

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# Progress 8 Score by Attendance Level

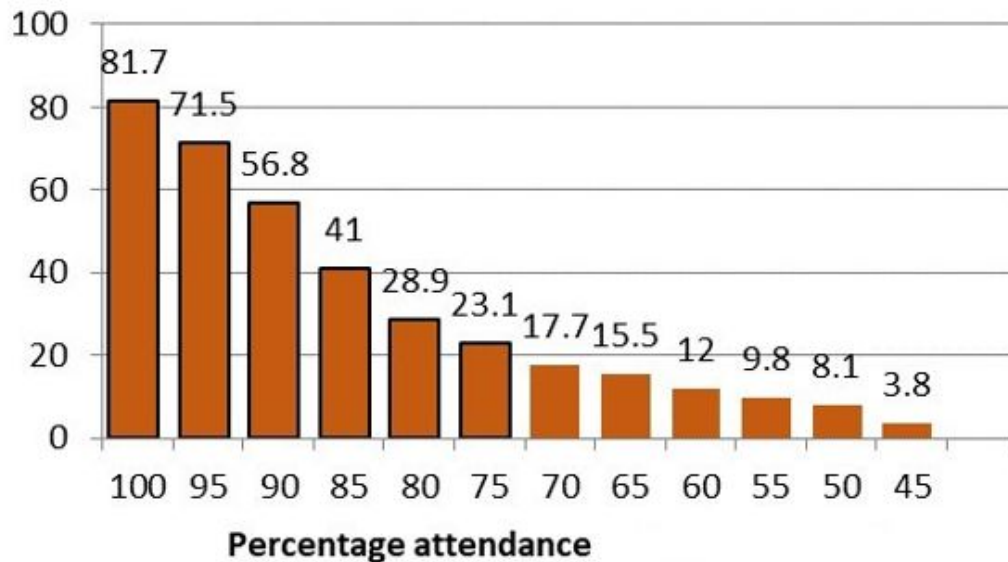




# Student Attainment by Attendance
