Autumn Term 2022



We are passionate about and committed to offering a varied and engaging [programme of activities](#) for students at Harrow Way. This builds on a successful legacy of sports clubs and performing arts opportunities and includes a commitment to providing engaging and challenging STEM activities. KS4 students are also offered the opportunity to achieve a Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award working with Andover Baptist Church.

To inform accurate record keeping and ensure the health and safety of students on site after school we have trialled a successful electronic registration system this term which is being used across all after school enrichment activities.

All year 7 and year 8 students are encouraged to take in at least one weekly enrichment activity and we are actively encouraging and challenging girls to take part in more STEM related opportunities.

We invite and encourage outside agencies and businesses to support and engage with activities. We [celebrate success](#) and attendance at enrichment; Heads of Year are encouraged to identify barriers to taking part with support being offered and provided to tackle issues if possible with a particular focus on SEND and disadvantaged students.

This term saw the return of performances planned and rehearsed by students in after school enrichment activities leading to performances such as the Christmas Concert. Amongst the numerous activities and outcomes from Stem clubs, students have produced items for the Christmas Fair and constructed a go-kart supported by local businesses and employees.
