EXAM TIMINGS & INFORMATION

Timings

- Morning exams start at 9.00am (you need to be at the exam location at least 10mins before this time). These show as 'a.m' on the timetable
- Afternoon exams start at 1.00pm (you need to be at the exam location at least 10mins before this time). These show as 'p.m' on the timetable
- All other sessions start at normal lesson times

HOW TO USE THIS BOOKLET

- Highlight, circle or mark all the exams, warm-ups and information that are relevant to you
- Always check your individual exam timetable as well

GENERAL ADVICE

- Check your school email every day for any changes or updates
- If you have any worries or anxieties then do speak to a member of the Year 11 team
- Attend all 'warm-up' sessions that have been planned for you
- Try to get an early night and a good night's sleep before exams
- Try to eat properly (something healthy) before the exam
- Arrive at school (and to the exam venue) in plenty of time before the start of the exam
- Check your equipment (in a clear plastic case):
 - Black pens and sharp pencils (and spares)
 - Eraser and ruler. Coloured pencils
 - Calculator (no case), protractor and compasses
