Advice for Students at Home

Sleep

Sleep is really important to help regulate our emotions and help cope with stress. Students should be aiming for 8-10 hours of uninterrupted sleep each night. Phones should be out of sight to avoid temptations. Some parents find it helpful to turn the wifi off during sleep hours. Students should establish a routine and stick to this.

Food

Whilst sweets and snacks can be motivating when revising, they do not provide sustainable energy and lead to burn out. Likewise, Red Bull and energy drinks are not advisable. Mr Briggs recommends dark chocolate as a treat!

Revision Plans:

Our advice to students has been to revise in short bursts and to have a 5 minute break every 25 minutes. Students should try to revise in a quiet area free from distractions (phones, TVs, people, etc). We have a new Y11 study hall in school that students can use if they don't have a space at home. Students should ensure they have an hour relaxing/winding down before going to bed at a suitable time- ideally away from a screen! Some students find it helpful if a copy of their revision timetable is in a central place (eg on the fridge) so that others at home can hold them accountable.
