Finance

All outstanding debts for Lunch loans or Music lessons need to be repaid via Scopay.

Money on your Year 11 child's Cashless Catering or General Prepayment account should be used up where possible. Any monies remaining will be transferred to sibling accounts if possible. If not, amounts over £5 will be refunded to parents via BACS after the students leaving date. Amounts under £5 will be donated to charity. In previous years any funds below £5 have been donated to the charity associated with our annual Charity Walk.
