

## Where do our students go after Harrow Way Community School?

The majority of our students, 98.4%, moved on to college or sixth form after their GCSEs to study a wide range of qualifications including A Levels and technical courses.

The most popular colleges for the 2025 leavers (184 students) were Sparsholt College Hampshire (including Andover College) - 76 students, Peter Symonds College in Winchester - 40 students, and Queen Mary's College in Basingstoke - 28 students. Year 11 leavers moving to an education programme also attended Basingstoke College of Technology.
